<p>Movement Gross motor skills: dancing, climbing, crawling, jumping, swinging, sliding, throwing a ball, grasping, catching, running, etc.</p>	<p>Language Reading aloud to your child; talking, singing, poetry, stories, books, and any spoken language.</p>	<p>Small Objects Fine motor skills. Stacking, sorting, organizing, putting into and taking out of containers, anything < 2" square.</p>	<p>Order Chores. Helping your child develop an appreciation for organization. Also called "practical" application.</p>
<p>Music Singing, listening to and or playing music. Making a joyful noise. Worship.</p>	<p>Toileting Potty-training, hygiene washing hands and brushing teeth</p>	<p>Character manners, honesty, integrity, sharing, responsibility, courtesy, etc.</p>	<p>Senses Smell, touch, taste, see and hear. Perfect for activities in the kitchen.</p>
<p>Writing Tracing, touching or holding a writing or coloring utensil - marker, pencil, crayon, and pen to create letters.</p>	<p>Reading Letter and word recognition. Learning phonetic sounds and sight words.</p>	<p>Spatial Shapes and puzzles. Deductive reasoning - science experiments, hypothesis testing.</p>	<p>Math Patterns, shapes, learning numbers, counting, adding, subtracting and later – division and multiplication.</p>
